SURFACE PREPARATION

New concrete should be fully cured for seven (7) days and free of all potential contaminants. For best results, air temperature must be above 35° F. If above 95° F or windy during application, keep hydrated with water for one hour. Then allow to damp dry and proceed with application.

NON GHP FLOOR or OUTDOORS

- 1. Thoroughly sweep all debris from floor. Auto-scrub or power wash any contaminants off of substrate. Leave no standing water. If necessary, use Green Umbrella Green Clean & Degreaser™ to remove stains. Make sure surface is clean of any residue.
- 2. Allow to dry.
- 3. Apply Green Umbrella HydroShield™ on any open concrete area with a Green Umbrella solution sprayer with a conical tip, or for large square footage, a solution spreader. Apply enough Green Umbrella HydroShield™ to achieve a dwell time of 20 to 30 minutes.
- 4. Distribute product with an exploded-tip bristle broom to ensure uniform coverage.
- 5. Allow to air dry or for accelerated drying by fans if absolutely necessary. Green Umbrella HydroShield™ will not gel on the surface and does not require rinsing.
- 6. Remove any un-reacted material with a broom after product has dried.

INDOOR/GHP FLOOR

It is best to densify with Green Umbrella Hydroshield[™] after first honing abrasive, yet applied prior to or after final hone or polish abrasive. It is recommended to apply after a 200 grit GUHr diamond abrasive, though you can Hone floors to a minimum 100 grit GUHr or a maximum of 800 grit GUPr.

- 1. Clean floor of slurry and contaminants with auto-scrubber prior to application of product. Leave no standing water. (Note: If the desired finish includes color, Green Umbrella ColorFlash™ may be applied before proceeding to the next step. Make sure all residue is cleaned off surface)
- 2. Allow to dry.
- 3. Apply Green Umbrella HydroShield™ with a Green Umbrella™ solution sprayer with a conical tip. Apply sufficient Green Umbrella HydroShield™ to achieve a dwell time of 20 to 30 minutes.
- 4. Distribute product with an exploded-tip bristle broom to ensure uniform coverage or a Green Umbrella™ T-Bar with a blended applicator when applying product over a dyed floor.
- 5. Allow to air dry or for accelerated drying by fans if absolutely necessary. Green Umbrella HydroShield™ will not gel on surface and does not require rinsing. One thorough application is all that is necessary.
- 6. After product has dried, broom off any un-reacted material or remove with an auto-scrubber.
- 7. Proceed to next GUHr or GUPr abrasive.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

- Regularly sweep away debris
- · Regularly auto-scrub or mop with water or Green Umbrella Green Clean Products™.

For GHP Floors periodically burnish with a high speed propane burnisher using Green Umbrella recommended non-resin transfer black pad to remove dirt build up and restore gloss.
