

VCT OR POLISHED CONCRETE?

Cut Labor


Cut maintenance labor.
A proper polished concrete floor is maintained by sweeping, mopping and occasionally burnishing. Stripping and waxing is not required. The labor saved over the life of a floor is significant.

Cut Down-time

In some cases polished concrete floors can be installed the same day as the placement. Moisture related issues with VCT glues are eliminated.

Cut Environmental Impact

At the end of VCT's life span it is pulled up and thrown into a landfill. More tile is manufactured, delivered and installed. Polished concrete uses what is already in the building, whether existing or new. A concrete slab does not need to be covered, it can be processed into flooring.



The Long Game

Comparing the installation and long-term (10 years) cost of VCT flooring and polished concrete. The sustainability of polished concrete is evident.
