Architect Kevin Schluckebier and BCDM designed an architectural concrete floor with a 4-color pattern throughout the facility. The initial concrete polishing contractor polished and colored the floor, but within months the color and gloss faded. Green Umbrella certified contractor True North Polishing was hired to repair and complete the project performing a complete re-profile, hone, and polish in only five days. Over 10,500 square feet of concrete were restored permanently with the 4-color pattern into the concrete using the Green Umbrella Color Defense system. Vivid, bold colors in the concrete, not on the surface.

Following with Shield & Enhance™, a concrete colorant that prevents oxidation of the dye at the surface by cross-linking to the treatments in the system, far superior to UV inhibitors — additionally adding salt with superior stain protection — then finishing the defense with Interior Microfilm™, a repairable wear-guard that brings clarity to the profile. Color Defense promotes bonding and cross-linking within the concrete without the negative side-effect of ASR or topical de-lamination found with other products. Maintain with GreenClean™, a LifeCycle™ cleaner with densifier built in that keeps the color in and drives contaminants out. This is the team that plays together.
